The book is composed of all new stories by new authors, but the purpose of this showcase is the same as its predecessors, *Short Stories by Short People* and *Who Says Adults Have to Write All the Good Stories?* : The pieces in it exemplify how young authors can apply the writing process to create works suitable for a wide audience. The collection is the result of a twelve-week process that allowed each student to take a basic idea of his or her choosing and develop it in ways that even the author may not have anticipated. From such rough material came this multi-faceted gem, in which the genres of humor, mystery, adventure, science fiction, historical fiction, horror, fantasy, and even nonfiction are represented.
